Oil Paints

A limited pallet of colors is recommended for this workshop:

Solvents

Masterpiece Odorless Thinner (Available at Hobby Lobby and highly recommended)

(Please don't bring any solvents that aren't "odorless")

Sealable container for thinner, preferably not glass

Brushes

Sable or synthetic brush bright, sable or synthetic pointed brush

Palette knife

Trowel shape, 2-3"

Palette for mixing colors

Paper or otherwise, grey or white, just be sure it's BIG.

Painting Surface

Canvas boards or stretched canvases

You'll need 2 - 8 x 10, or 9 x 12

Easel

Table or standing; a french easel works fine

Drawing supplies

We will be drawing with a brush

Also, LOTS of paper towels, Plastic bags for trash
